### WOODCREAM APPLICATION IN 6 SIMPLE STEPS

> Preparation in case of renovation of older, non-Rubio Monocoat coatings: Remove any loose weathered coatings or wood fibres from previous treatments.













- > Is your wood too weathered to start sanding right away? Then clean it first with water/Exterior Wood Cleaner. By removing a lot of dirt beforehand, your sandpaper won't get clogged up from the start.
- > Powerwashing can cause serious damage to the wooden surface. We recommend using a garden hose instead. If you insist on powerwashing, use caution to avoid damage (no more than 34,5 - 55 BAR or 500-800 PSI and do not get too close to the surface).
- > Coarser sanding improves product adhesion and performance.
- > When the existing coating system is in very poor shape, remove the remaining coating system completely and treat it as new wood.
- > Do not allow the solution with Exterior Wood Cleaner to dry before rinsing off.
- > In case of two layers: The second application will not adhere to the first (already water-repellent) layer as easily. We recommend spreading the product with the WoodCream Brush on the first layer in one smooth movement and going over it several times.

#### STEP 1

Sand the surface scratch-free according to industry standards. Final sanding grit should be 120.

#### STEP 2

Prepare the surface. Clean it with Exterior Wood Cleaner and a nylon scrubbing brush (wear gloves!). Use a mixture of 10% Exterior Wood Cleaner and 90% water (depending on the soiling or weathering of the wood, a stronger ratio may be required). Rinse well with clean water afterwards and allow the surface to dry well.

#### STEP 3

Application on new or untreated wood: Stir WoodCream well before applying it (undiluted).

Application on older, non-Rubio Monocoat coatings: Stir WoodCream thoroughly before use and add 25 - 50% WoodCream Softener to the product.

#### STEP 4

Apply carefully and evenly to the vertical surface with a WoodCream Brush, in the lengthwise direction of the wood. Tip: we advise to keep a wet edge to avoid overlaps.

#### STEP 5

Work in zones of 3 to 4 boards in the direction of the wood fibre. Spread out the product in one go with the application brush and go over it several times.

#### STEP 6

Application on new or untreated wood: Allow the surface to dry 12 hours or apply a second application in case a more opaque result is desired.

Application on older, non-Rubio Monocoat coatings: Apply a second layer to prevent gloss differences between raw wood and patches where the old coating was still present.

Always add WoodCream Softener for the second layer and apply after at least 3 hours of drying time and preferably within 24 hours.

It is therefore best to carry out a yearly visual check-up just after winter season. Do you see some fading of colour or a diminished wood protection? Then the WoodCream Softener combined with WoodCream is the ideal maintenance partner.

The WoodCream Softener is also the perfect WoodCream partner to create different colour effects.

By adding the Softener you can decrease the colour intensity of the existing WoodCream colours to achieve a more transparent effect. WoodCream Softener also offers the solution for fans of an **instant aged look**: mix one of the colours from the Grey Collection with WoodCream Softener.

### **UNIQUE CHARACTERISTICS**

- >0% VOC

### WOODCREAM SOFTENER APPLICATION FOR COLOUR EFFECTS OR MAINTENANCE

#### When to dilute with WoodCream Softener (ratio 9:1 to max 1:1)?

- To create a more transparent effect
- To create an instant aged look on new wood (dilute one of the colours from the Grey colour collection)
- > With roughsawn, very porous or dry wood (<14%)  $\rightarrow$  easier application
- > In case of application in 2 layers  $\rightarrow$  more covering effect
- > In case of high temperatures (>  $30^{\circ}$ C) or when there is no shadow  $\Rightarrow$  longer drying time and easier application
- > In case of maintenance or renovation

















> Avoid direct sunlight on the surface.

#### WARNING

Adding WoodCream Softener re-duces the UV resistance of the product. This can cause premature discolouration. This discolouration effect depends on the amount of WoodCream Softener added.



#### STEP 1 - 3

Clean the wood. Use a mixture of 10% Exterior Wood Cleaner and 90% water (make sure the product does not get in the eyes). Clean the surface again with low pressure water and a soft brush; sanding is not necessary. Consult the technical datasheet before use

#### STEP 4 - 5

Mix, stir and dilute WoodCream with WoodCream Softener at a ratio of 9 units WoodCream to 1 unit Wood-Cream Softener (adjust ratio for the desired result to max 1:1).

#### STEP 6



Apply the mixture: spread out the product in one go, carefully and evenly, in the direction of the wood fibre. Go over it several times. Work in zones of 3 to 4 boards. It's best to work wet-in-wet.

In general we recommend a yearly visual check-up just after winter season.

> Are you applying a second layer of WoodCream? Then dilute it this time with 25%, or up to 50% WoodCream Softener to avoid excessive build-up. The second layer can be applied after at least 3 hours of drying time and
